

Are connected to


Signified – the meaning Ideas, meaning and culture such as:

- × Stable
- × Strong

- × reliable

OVAL SHAPES:



- × Safe
- × Soft
- × Friendly
- × Harmless
- × Naive
- × 'young'
- Used in very young (baby) or older (grandma) characters

TRIANGULAR SHAPES:



- × Dangerous
- × Villainous
- × Determination
- × Powerful
