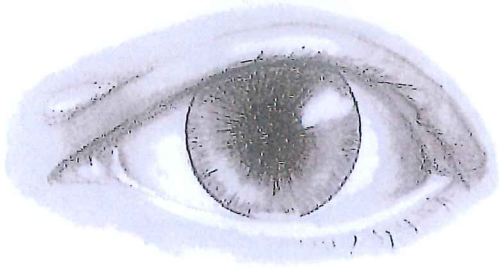


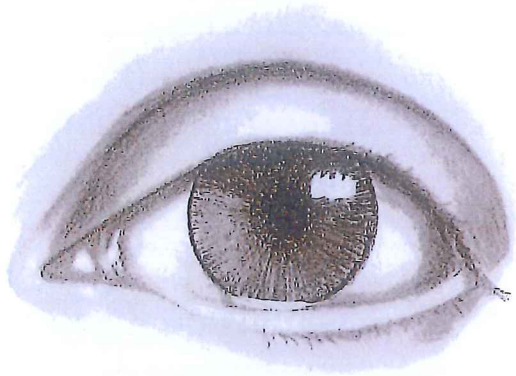
EYELID CREASES

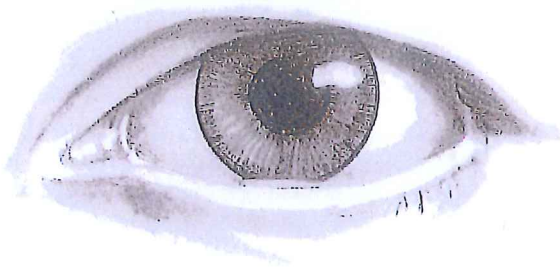
Above the eye, the upper eyelid forms a crease. In the average eye, this looks like a line following the upper eyelid. Eyelids with a crease that is very high above the eye are called "heavy lids." Eyelids with a crease that is close to the eye or doesn't show at all are called "overhanging lids." Pay close attention to the location, direction and appearance of the upper lid crease.
