INTRODUCTORY PARAGRAPH

Questions 1-11 DO NOT need to be answered in sentence form.

- 1. What is the name of the artist?
- 2. What is the name of the artwork (Remember every time you use this it must be either underlined or in inverted commas and in capital letters) E.g. <u>RED GOLD</u> or "Red Gold".
 - 3. Where could you find this piece of work?
 - 4. Where was the artist born?
 - 5. When was the artist born?
 - 6. In what year did the artist die?
 - 7. How old was the artist when he/she died?
 - 8. What size is this work?
 - 9. What is the shape of this artwork e.g. square, horizontal rectangle, vertical rectangle, oval (this is called the FORMAT).
 - 10. What is the work made from? (This is called the MEDIUM).
 - 11. In which year was this piece made?

Answer questions 12 -15 in sentence form. Read questions carefully.

- 12. Now use the answers to questions 1,2 and 3 to write a descriptive sentence, e.g. Hans Heysen painted "Red Gold" which can be found in the Art Gallery of South Australia.
- 13. Beginning with the artist's name, write another sentence using the answers to questions 4, 5, 6 and 7. E.g. Hans Heysen was born in Germany inn1877 and died in 1968 at the age of 91.
- 14. Start your third sentence with the name of the artwork. Use the answers from questions 8, 9, and 10 to complete the sentence. E.g. "Red Gold" is oil on canvas in a horizontal rectangular format measuring 127.6 \times 172.1 cms
- 15. Your fourth and final sentence must include the answer to question No. 11 e.g. it was painted in 1913.

Ask teacher to check your answers to questions 12, 13, 14, and 15. After you have corrected any mistakes rewrite your sentences into a paragraph.
